



WELCOME TO HIGHLANDS MONTESSORI

We would like to extend a warm welcome to Highlands Montessori. We are delighted that your child will be joining our school, and look forward to getting to know your family better throughout the coming year. We feel honored to partner with your family to help your child grow in his/her path toward independence and self-discovery.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Arrival-

- Arrival is from 8:30-8:45; before care begins at 7:30
- Late arrivals should be prearranged with staff. Consistent interruptions disrupt the Montessori work cycle and concentration of the children
- For safety, doors are locked. The front and back **door code is 1896**

Sign-In/ Out-

- Please sign your child in/out using the Brightwheel app:
 - Tap check in/ out, scan QR code in app, check in child, sign your name

Drop Off-

- Drop-offs can be tough for little ones, but it's best to keep it short and sweet. This helps them feel secure. Save longer conversations for dismissal.

Dismissal-

- Pickup is from 2:45-3:00 PM, aftercare pickup by 5:30 PM.
- Late pickups incur a \$1/minute fee, increasing to \$5/minute after 15 minutes. Excessive lateness may result in program dismissal.
- Children are released only to those on the approved pickup list; photo ID is required for unfamiliar pickups. Changes to the list can be made via the Brightwheel app.

Absences/Late Arrivals-

- Please message us if your child will be absent or will be arriving late

WHAT TO BRING:

- 3-5 complete changes of clothing: shirt, pants, socks
- Diapers, wipes, and creams
- Indoor shoes
- Blanket for rest time
- Lunch (in container that the child can easily open)
- Waterbottle

****All belongings (clothing, containers, shoes, bottles, etc.) must be clearly labeled with your child's name***

ILLNESS POLICY:

If a child becomes ill while attending the program, parents will be immediately contacted to pick their child up and the child will be isolated from other students.
